Large Crowds Attend Massart Auctioneers Weekday Auctions

The estate auction of Fred Kuehl took place on Monday, September 22 at 11:00AM. It took place live on location of Fred's homestead in Forestville, Wisconsin. It was a small auction with only 225 lots being offered. There were 191 bid cards issued with over 300 in attendance.

Top honors of the day went to this 1970 Jaguar E Type convertible that sold to a happy phone bidder from Minnesota for \$55,000. A happy in house bidder paid \$5,390 for a 1957 Harley Davidson. Other prices realized were: German Nazi hat \$341, Sword with Japanese markings \$176, Cylinder record player \$242, Gas pump \$605, Milling machine \$1,485 & a South Bend quick change gear lathe sold for \$2,530.

This beautiful 1957 Harley-Davidson motorcycle brought a high bid of \$5,390.

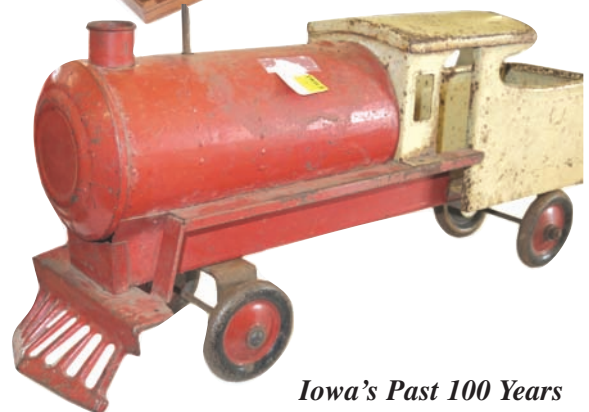

Twenty-Two Years & Growing at the Dodgeville Lions Club Antique Sale & Flea Market

Dodgeville, Wisconsin. It's a town that means different things to different people. History buffs know it as one of the Badger State's oldest European settlements, founded in 1829. Surprisingly, at one time it was also the largest city in Wisconsin with a population then greater than Milwaukee's and Chicago's combined. And historical sites are all around it too, including the nearby Pendarvis State Historical Site in Mineral Point among many others.

Outdoor enthusiasts know it as the gateway to the many natural attractions in the State's famed driftless region, from Governor Dodge State Park to the scenic Wisconsin River Valley. The outdoor fun continues all winter at the region's popular ski & snowboard resort, Tyrol Basin.

And many vacationers know it as a convenient base for visiting the numerous nearby manmade attractions. Notable destinations include everything from the famed House on the Rock to Frank Lloyd Wright's Taliesin to kids' favorites like Cave of the Mounds and Circus World Museum.

And for the past twenty-two years, Dodgeville has also played host to what has become one of the best antique & flea markets in southwest Wisconsin: the Dodgeville Lions Club Antique Sale & Flea Market.

Held twice each year, in June and again in August, the one-day sale fills Harris Park's Ley Pavilion with sixty dealers and attracts hundreds of shoppers. It's an easy

and scenic drive from almost anywhere too - only an hour west of Madison, two hours from Milwaukee, or three from Chicago. And as it's a Dodgeville Lions Club organized event, all the proceeds from the show help fund projects right in the community.

The exhibitors range from locals selling family treasures to quality antique dealers from both near & far. Some have been coming for most or all of the shows two-decade history, like local collectors Marion & Jack Reynolds. They always have one of the biggest displays at the show, their booth brimming with local finds from steamer trunks to some choice early agricultural implements.

The country theme continued in Dixie & Ken Delkamp's display, where I found primitives including a nice saddle maker's bench and a rustic yarn winder. No matter what your interests, you'll probably find it here, from The Green Knight's excellent collection of vintage military memorabilia to the countless vintage tools at Carriage House Woodworks.

Why not plan to visit the Dodgeville Lions Club Antique Sale & Flea Market in 2015, for either the June or August shows - or maybe both! 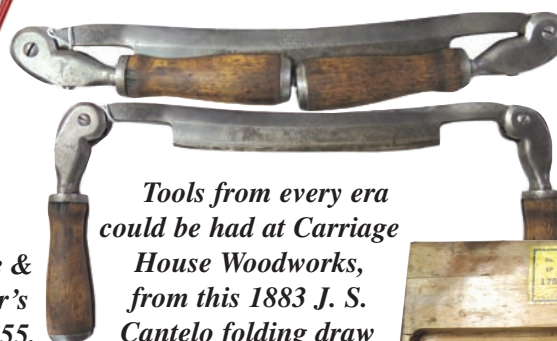

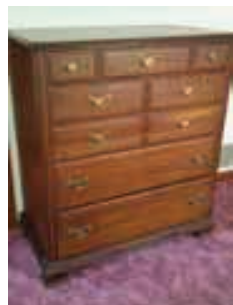

By buying this chair to use again we have conserved our natural resources and prevented the carbon footprint of another chair being produced, that possibly would come all the way from the Far East. I expect that a new mass produced chair will hit the waste dump long before the antique Windsor chair is sold again at auction, goes to the restorers to be revived and is retailed again for another 40 years use!

* By buying antiques and collectibles... and putting them into use, rather than buying a new product, is what "Antiques are Green" is all about. What a wonderful way for collecting clubs, for antique malls, flea markets, shows and auction houses to promote "going green" to younger consumers and buyers. This is another approach for reaching out to the young audience of 20-35 and showing how antiques can be an integral part of their lives while helping the environment all at the same time.

* Finding antiques and decorative objects to decorate your living space or work place is a great way to personalize your home or office and make it uniquely yours. Furnishing or redecorating your first apartment or home with old objectives makes economic sense, as well as "green sense."

* Vintage clothing... and clothing accessories are currently hot among young adults. We're talking buttons, fabric, jewelry, hats - either to wear or as decoration. Old advertising items and other graphic arts, movie posters and political posters, kitchen items, pottery and glassware, toys, music-related items, old record players and radios, old bottles, even vintage automobiles... the listing is endless, but can all tie in to the Green about Antiques concept. 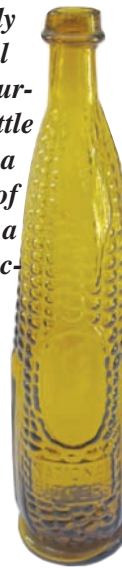

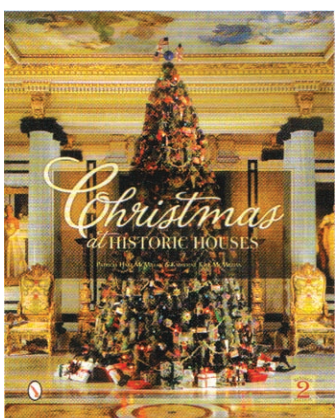

The faq section (frequently asked questions) is very simple and yet, very helpful. This is a section that should be considered on every collecting club's website. It simply and briefly answers questions like: Who belongs? How do I determine the value of items? Are there Society shows that are open to the public? How do I determine when an item was made? Where can I get more information? etc.

By spending only a couple of minutes on the site, if a visitor has an interest in collecting or studying golf memorabilia, it would be hard to resist joining!

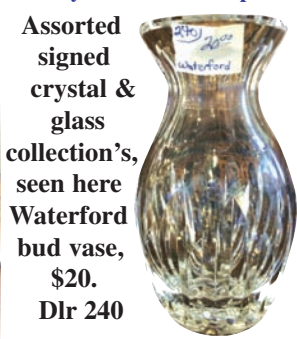

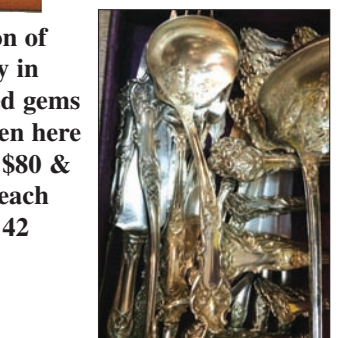
